Just got about halfway through "Starfighter," and had to put it down. The author apparently has written over nineteen (19) other novels, which is surprising. How can someone so prolific, be so inept at basic writing skills, editing and proofreading? It's as if a draft made it into commercial release without having been fully finished. From nearly the first page (loc-why is page numbering such an anathema?) errors appear: missing words, imprecise language not indicating which character is speaking or the objective, and many other flaws. These are not blemishes nor stylistic, but rather faults. It is unprofessional for ANY commercially published product and unacceptable. It is a shame, as the story had potential merit: starfreighter crew, mainly ex combatants from a recent

stellar war, rescue an military anthropologist/special operator from a recently discovered, ancient alien settlement, pursuant to a massacre of her team and the destruction of a space station by human military elements. Most characterizations are reasonable, except for the lead character, ex-major and freighter captain. He's portrayed as a sensitive, self destructive, high functioning alcoholic, selfish, divorced father, dealing with "issues"- basically the stereotypical victim of PTSD. The characterization shows how clueless Mr. Tongue, the eBook author is.Will try to continue with the book again, but if the sloppy, lazy work production goes on throughout the remaining 50%, rating will be revisited and downgraded.Read via Kindle Limited.Came back to reading the book and finished it. Lead character still a whiney loser.
