

Good stories, but needs an editor and a proofreader. Example: Dad parked up outside. Or talking to one person and answering another. A few pages had so many errors I had to stop and decipher what was meant. It took some of the pleasure out of the book. Also, no fair keeping the final bit of information secret. Each ending we find Jane saw something that wasn't mentioned in the book which becomes the key to the solution. I enjoy two of the three sisters, Lizzy still remains a charachature after 8 books. Aggie is little better, and let's get to the hunters or drop them.

I love this series because I have only been able to figure out 2 of the murders before they were revealed. I read these fun light hearted books to help keep my mind off chronic pain. When is the next book?I'm not from Maine so some of the British/Canadian colloquial comments threw me, but then I have a concussion.

I liked the idea behind all three books, but I felt that the characters need to be fleshed out more, in order to give readers a reason to follow the series. All three books start out with the same premise, the victim fights with a bunch of people and then ends up dead. Jane is a friend of either the victim or the suspect and gets involved with trying to solve the murder with the help of her sisters. Then she solves the murder after talking to her dad. Boom, book over. It needs more content, more daily activities aside from solving the case, more back history and character interaction. At the end, it leaves more questions then answers and a big feeling of being left hanging instead of contentment of a good book that makes you want to return again and again.

More characters development could help, but I'm not sure how much. The mystery is solved after the dad speaks (or after the cat speaks), the civilian sets up the sting after giving the order to the pros to wait in the wings in Crystal Cove (or is it Enchanted Bay?). Wait, which witch is which?! P. S. A boyfriend who answers a query about his interest in another woman with "You know you don't need to be worried. She is way out of my league," should possibly be an EX-boyfriend.

If you are looking for a light book with good twists this would be good. A definite beach book. I am reading the series and like the characters. However, the plots are becoming tedious and the dialogue between Jane and Max along with their relationship has stalled. I am hoping they move forward in the next book.

A perfect book to kick back, enjoy the day with. The characters make me smile as I root for Jane and Max, and hope that all goes well for Jane and her mother. And secretly? It makes me hope that there are witches like Jane and her family in the world
