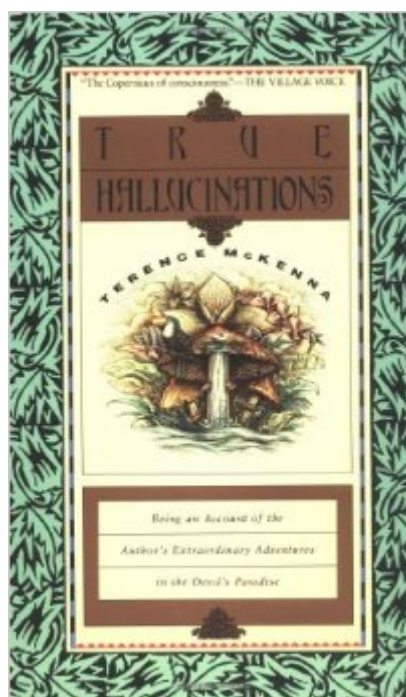

I was really disappointed with this book.
