

If you like cozy mysteries, excellent writing, and well-defined characters, you will enjoy Address to Die For. The McDonald family moves to a new (old) home in a new place and has a terrifying

introduction to the area, which includes two murders and serious vandalism to the McDonald house. The seriousness of the crimes is balanced by humor and quirky characters. The writing here is much better than what is found in the typical first novel. I look forward to reading more Maggie McDonald mysteries.

This is the first in a brand new series featuring Maggie MacDonald by author Mary Feliz. Maggie McDonald, her husband, Max, and their two sons, David and Brian, are moving Max's Great Aunt Kay's 100-year-old California Craftsman house that Max inherited in Orchard View, California which is a small town located in the hills above Silicon Valley. Maggie is a professional organizer and Max is starting a new job. When they arrive, they are shocked and upset because of the condition of the house and property and concerned because the estate's caretaker, Javier Hernandez, has slacked off on his duties. While inspecting the house, Max notices an awful smell and searches to find the source. Sadly, he discovers the body of Javier in the basement. The house is deemed a crime scene and the family moves into the barn because there are no local hotels. Max's new employer sends him overseas, the house and property are vandalized, a mailbox bomb, rocks are thrown through the windows, and arson occurs. Detective Jason Mueller assigns his consultant, Stephen Laird and his German Shepherd, Mozart move in and protect the family until the vandals and killer are caught. The investigation reveals secrets about local townsfolk and unearths several suspects. I received a copy of this book in exchange for an honest review from NetGalley.

You know how there are some books where you can read the first two pages, and know, absolutely know, that this is going to be one of your "bestest" books of the year? That's it, with "Address to Die For". Never heard of the author before, never heard of the book, but rolled the dice on a 99 cent special -- and it's better than most of the books I spent ten times more on. Let's just say Miz Feliz' book made me muy feliz - with her great writing, solid plot and engaging setting. It's delightful -- you feel you know the characters from the get-go, there's a really nice Golden, a beautiful old house that presents ah.... challenges, shall we say. But don't read any more of what I have to say -- you're wasting time! Go get the book! You're gonna love it!

This is a debut cozy mystery by author Mary Feliz. It is a well written story with a main character who is likable and personable. There is also a good, solid cast of secondary characters whom I think readers will enjoy. The mystery was well thought out with plenty of suspects who had viable motives for committing the acts of vandalism and murder. I did feel that there was a lull in the first half of the book. The story started out strong, with the finding of a dead body, but then the mystery felt like it took a back seat to the rest of the story.
