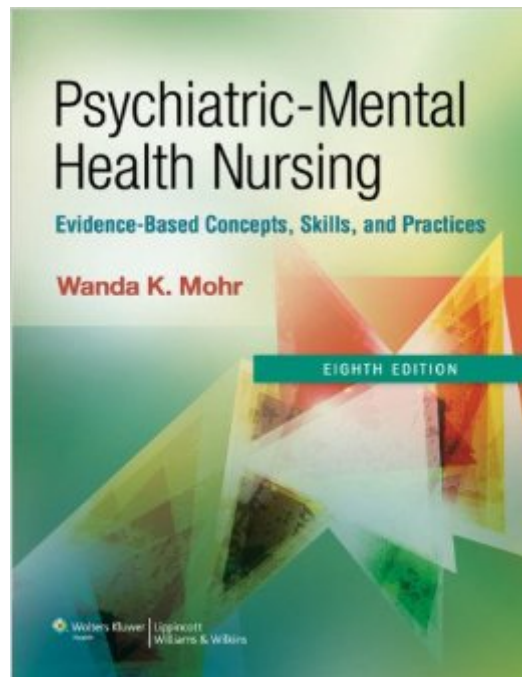

The realm of psychiatric-mental health nursing is my domain. However, never have I delved into a text that was as unhelpful, bland, lacking in depth, and organized in such an awkward manner as this. I do not recommend it at all and am discouraged that it is required in some nursing curricula.

This is an easy to read textbook which first covers general concepts in psychiatric nursing; then goes on to cover specific disease processes and their treatment. Basic anatomy and physiology, working with individuals and families, pharmacology and communication are covered. An excellent text which covers many aspects of psychiatric nursing.

I bought this in place of the 8th (newest) edition. I am unsure what the differences are (apparently the 8th edition lists them in the front). I have been using this for the nursing program and it is a lovely reference tool.
