

I remember in 1979 as a wee lad reading (and perhaps seeing on TV news, but cannot recall the details) about the attack on Mecca. I had always wondered what really happened. In ca. 2008, I saw this book at (then still in business) Border's on the shelf--picked it up, thought, "Hey, I should read this!" Then I (stupidly) put it back. Fortunately, our local library had it. This is an amazing account, and some may question whether or not Trofimov's book can be compared favorably (if at all) to the Looming Tower (Lawrence Wright, The Looming Tower: Al-Qaeda and the Road to 9/11). Well, of course it can! Masterfully written, very well researched, and with a fascinating, fast-paced but exceptionally well-detailed narrative, this critical work provides key historical connections between modern radical Islam, and recent threats not only to the Muslim world but especially to the West (and that includes Israel, of course). The fanatic, macabre death-wish frenzy of our enemies can be

traced back further, of course, but this book (Siege of Mecca) is one of the best modern accounts of its contorted genesis. And given the sensitivity and seclusion of the main subject, i.e., Mecca, The Siege of Mecca will likely be the only definitive account--unless the Kingdom ever decides to make public its archives on the tragic and very violent battle at Islam's holiest of holies.

For anyone struggling to understand the various sects within Islam, this book helps explain the animosities and tensions that exist. I don't remember ever hearing about this event until I read the book.

I had a difficult time putting down this book. I never heard of it until I was in a seminar and it was recommended to me to better understand Islamic extremism. It was VERY informative and actually a bit exciting if a book can be that way. I learned a LOT.

This is a fantastic book about the siege of Mecca (the Muslim holy place in Saudi Arabia) that happened on the morning of November 20, 1979. On that early morning, the first day of a new Muslim Century, hundreds of Muslim killers stormed God's Mosque (also known as the House of God) in Mecca, taking hostages and declaring Jihad against the House of Saud (Saudi Arabia's ruling family). The aim of Juhayman al Uteybi, the jihadist leader, was to overthrow the house of Saud and restore Muslim democracy. The bloody siege lasted two weeks. Many mistakes were made by these jihadist. First, these men were defiling Islam's holiest shrine. God forbid violence and bloodshed in the Grand Mosque. Their action was contrary to Muslim doctrines. Second, an attack on the House of Saud should have been an attack on Al Saud's family, not against God. Storming the Grand Mosque was an attack on Islam, and in the process, many innocent Muslim pilgrims died. Third, the jihadist believed that the Mahdi (in Muslim belief, a spiritual man who is believed to welcome the coming of Jesus Christ on Earth) was among them. The Saudi royal family, with their little army of untrained men, was unable to fight off the jihadist, suffering many casualties. In desperation they enlisted the help of French commandos led by Captain Paul Barril. He used poison gas to finally knock out the insurgents. I really enjoyed reading this book, and honestly, couldn't put it down. It reads like a spy novel. The reader will gain much insight into the politics of Saudi Arabia, and what is more important, about the rise of the present jihadist terrorist attacks around the world. This is a necessary book for anyone wanting to understand why the September 11 attacks on US soil occurred. I highly recommend this book!

Trofimov reveals the surprising truth about the origin of "radical islamic fundamentalism". A well researched, well writtem and very informative book. Trofimov is a great writer.
