

In this powerful book, Carol Ochs shows us how to develop a personal theology by examining our life stories, learning to recognize God at work in them, and bringing them into conversation with Torah. Armed with our personally shaped theology, we can face this adventure of living in the vanguard of history with awareness and confidence.
