

Let me start by saying, I never take the time to write reviews of books. I figure, the other hundreds (or thousands) of readers will do so, and I generally trust their opinions. This one, however... I feel compelled to review. My second point befpre my review: I eagerly awaited the arrival of this book. I even pre-ordered it. So, what I'm saying is I was really looking forward to reading the book. That is,

perhaps, why my disappointment was so acute. The other books painted Nathan as a tortured (both literally and figuratively) and tormented man. What was appealing about him, though, was that he was brutal yet human. He was disarmingly honest about his flaws and his savagry. This book had none of that. This was one, long wait for a final battle scene with the antagonist. Peterson went into excruciating detail about how Nathan (and his partner, Harv) set up surveillance and moved around this little town. Nothing happened. "Move 600 yards north, and confirm your arrival." So-and-so gave a confirmatory click. "Now, move 200 yards west, conceal yourself by the wall." So-and-so gave a confirmatory click. Can you imagine hundreds of pages like that? Here is an aside... these guys are supposed to be hardened killers. Intelligent, highly trained, but 'real'. Yet... these guys never curse. I don't mean to say that I think it should be "Catcher in the Rye." What I'm saying is that I'm a highly educated, professional woman, and I curse more than these characters. There are just times when dropping an f'bomb is appropriate. It adds to the unfiltered and coarse world these characters inhabit. Yet... this book had none of that. In summation: I couldn't wait to read this book.
