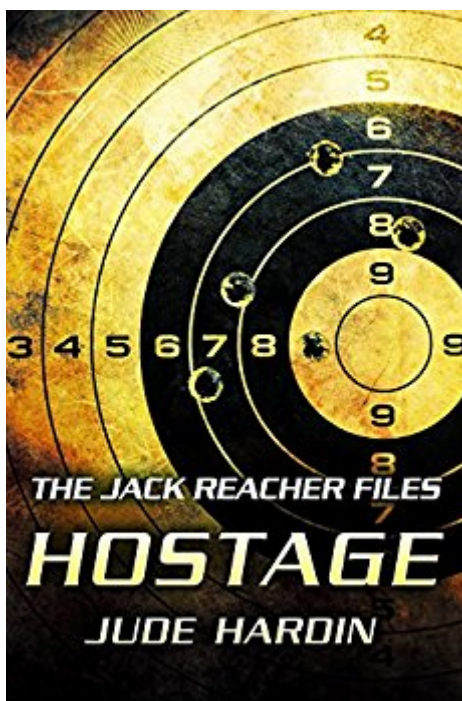

In light of Jack Reacher's history as presented by Lee Child, I see no room in Reacher's life to be involved with a terrorist organization called CHOKE. Nor is it easy to comprehend why he is on the US Government's hit list. Throughout Jude Hardin's writing, I have difficulty reconciling the good-guys and bad-guys, or seeing where is the line between the two groups.
