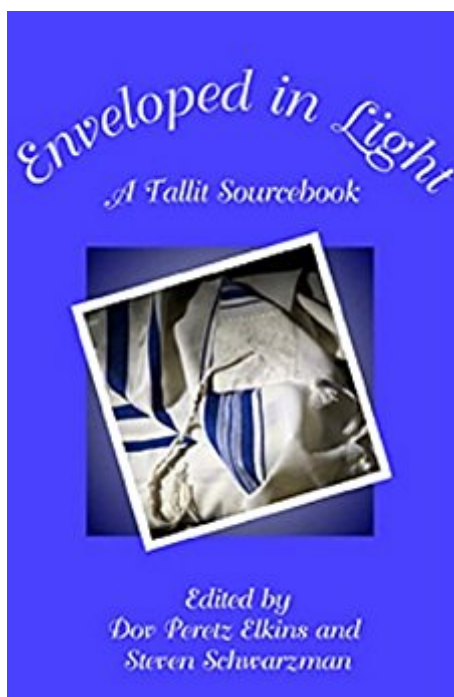

The tallit has been around for a few thousand years (as you will learn in

some of the historically-oriented contributions herein), but there have also been some exciting developments in just the last few decades as the recipe for tekhelet â “ the blue dye for tzitzit â “ has apparently been rediscovered and women have begun (or begun again, as you will read!) to wear tallitot in some communities. We hope that this sourcebook will help more people learn about the beauty of the tallit and its rich potential as a ritual item in adding a spiritual and ethical dimension to Jewish prayer and life.â •
