Rudolf Joseph Lorenz Steiner (1861-1925) was an Austrian religious philosopher and esotericist, who was once a leader in the German section of the Theosophical Society, but broke with them after refusing to acknowledge Jiddu Krishnamurti as the coming "World Teacher." Steiner then founded the Anthroposophical Society, and began an influential system of schools ("Waldorf Schools") based on his educational ideas. He wrote many other books, such as An Outline of Occult Science, Knowledge of the Higher Worlds and its Attainment: An Esoteric Spiritualism Initiation, etc. [NOTE: page numbers below refer to the 221-page 1994 paperback edition.]He wrote in the Preface to the Third Edition, "Since the purpose of this book is to depict some portions of the supersensible world, anyone believing only in the validity of the sense-perceptible world will take it as a
