

I enjoy reading Leighann Dobbs' books, so when she started a new series, I was thrilled. I read a lot of cozy mysteries, and several things struck me about this one. Firstly, this book is engaging. The

characters are introduced in a way that doesn't interfere with the plot but leaves you wanting to know just a little more. I love being drawn into a town and a family in this way. The characters are realistic, believable, and varied. The dialogue is smartly written and reveals more about the characters over time. There is a good mix of humor, information, and intrigue that comes through. Another thing I really enjoyed about this book is that I was positive I had figured out who the killer was, was certain the main character was chasing the wrong suspect, and was quite surprised at the twist at the end. In fact, there were a couple of twists at the end that I thoroughly enjoyed. By the time I got to The End, I was cheering the author for a job well done and didn't want the story to be over yet. I can't wait for the next installment of Mystic Notch. I enjoyed the paranormal elements of this story and felt that they gave an aura of magic and mystery that will be slowly added to over time in the series. I especially loved the unusual "regulars" who visit the book store on occasion as well as the supremely intelligent cats who could almost steal the show. I only wish that Ms. Dobbs could write as fast as I read.

I will say that I am a Leighann Dobbs fan. I love the Lexy Baker series as well as the Blackmoore Sisters. I thought that Hidden Agenda, the Kate Diamond adventure, was one of her best. But this one? I think it's the best of all of them. Small town folks, an awesome cat pointing in all kinds of directions, a best friend with magical teas...that frequently backfire...and a mystery that I didn't solve prior to the exciting ending all made for an exciting read. I laughed, I teared up...and I'm not an easy mark for that. This novel was great, and I can't wait for the next one.

I really like animals and ghost stories with a little magic mixed in. Ghostly Paws had it all. I love that authors are starting to write stories with the heroine a normal type person. you know - not beautiful, with everything just right and waiting for mr right. Our heroine has a limp and isn't looking for anything except to run her bookstore. she has crazy friends, that I would love to hang out with. I really enjoyed this book and hope to read more of this in the future.

I thought that this book was interesting and it was also a quick read. I think that the main character was too quick to condemn and to put herself into trouble. I hope that the next book in this series will be a little better .

This book started off strong and was enjoyable to read. However, it started going downhill about halfway through. I actually gave up on it and when I want to read "fluff", I will finish it. It's not a bad story, I just like stories and mysteries with more "meat" to them. If anyone is wanting a really good cat mystery, try the Joe Grey ones. They are much better and more suited to adults rather than preteens like this one.

I think this was a good, solid cozy mystery. I enjoyed the paranormal aspects of the story---the ghosts and the cats, especially. I wasn't enthused with the characters names---seemed old-fashioned to me.
