

I don't often like every story in an anthology, but I did in this one, even though the stories were quite different. Some made me laugh, one made me cry (my favorite!), some gave me chills, some made me think and reassess my beliefs and opinions (are they serving me?), and many made me want to look into other works by the authors. AND, two of them had dogs in them - my favorite species after my own, except for the times when they go to number one because of my own! (Oh yes, there were also a few badd-ass women - but I digress). Even though I liked them all to one degree or another, here are my three favs. (1) The Epsilon Directive, by David Bruns. David is one of my favorite authors. I follow his work religiously, and I have loved everything he has written. If you are new to his writing, buy his books and treat yourself to some great reads! This story is about - as he describes him - " a reluctant soldier, a closet conscientious objector, turned draftee" - who tries to do the right thing, and then is forced to watch it all fall apart - even asked to condone a horrible act. I won't give anything else away, but , after I read the story, I sat for a long time, trying to imagine being in his shoes while he tries to cope with his pain and disappointment. Yes, this is the story that made me cry, and to be moved that much - well, to me, that is worth ten stars! (Oh, I almost forgot that there is also a great miracle at the end - one known only to our hero - so it's not all sad). And, because of that, I loved this story even more! (2) Second Chance, by Nick Webb. This story was fun

and made me laugh.
