

Even though there are no illustrations or links as advertised, it's easy enough to create your own links on your Kindle:1. Do a search for the title of a book2. Create a highlight for the title3. SaveThen when you view your notes and highlights, all the book titles you have highlighted are right there. You can go to any book you want within the completed works. I've been a student of the AA Bailey works for years. They are an extension/continuation of the works of Blavatsky. Both are worthy of study if you are interested in theosophy and the Ageless Wisdom Teachings.

I don't know what everyone is talking about. If you use the "go to" function on the kindle you can

select the different sections of the ebook, meaning a list appears that acts exactly like a table of contents

This download is the best deal I have found on . There are no links or illustrations. You have to scroll through to find each book, and bookmark each title. It's worth the task. I do hope someday they include links and illustrations as advertised. I still give it five stars.

Always wanted to read some of Madame Blavatsky's writings, and this looks like a good compilation. It's 99 cents, so I don't expect a lot other than the text. It is a low cost item, and whoever did the "publishing" didn't even bother to get her name right. One would think that somewhere along the line, they would correct this, but it's a cheap read. Hopefully whoever did the ocr got most of the words right. Update: Thanks Lunaria for catching the typo in the title. Fixed now, and yes it was ironic. Looks like the OCR is not too bad, but the TOC is worthless. Some of the entries don't even get the title of the section right so you can't even do a search to find the article. All in all, it's not a bad deal but don't expect too much from a 99 cent ebook.

I'm not asking for anything fancy, but couldn't they just have a link to each book? Like I'm supposed to got through 7000 pages and bookmark titles?!!!!

This is a huge collection of Helena Petrovna Blavatsky's works in one place for an unheard of price. Like many kindle editions, no illustrations for these very old texts. Links? What links? You'll need to create your own, but worth the effort. This series would make a perfect set for a metaphysical study group alone or as an adjunct to the Bailey material (Alice A Bailey). Blavatsky founded the Theosophical Society in 1875. An amazing woman now, and even more amazing in her time, she traveled extensively in search of answers. She is responsible for bringing Buddhism to the Western world. Her works on the ancient wisdom was the start of the new age movement as we know it today. Her works may be a little difficult for the beginner to understand since 19th century language is so different. But with some basic ground work (like Alice A Bailey's works) you should be able to work your way thru. A study group with a leader who has some experience with this material is always advantageous, but should not be a deterrent for the determined seeker. There are texts here that are extremely hard to come by. Theosophical student to occultist, inquiring mind to scholar, worth the time and the read.

Kindle suggests that you can get to each item through the table of contents (w/Links). Wrong! You have to scroll through each page of each title to get to the one you want. Yes, it's all there (I assume), but it is a pain to get to the last few titles.

I have discovered that there are navigation links embedded in the files. Once you open the file press the right arrow on the 5-way controller (below 'menu' button and above 'back' button) This key will cycle you through each of the books. The books are illustrated from what I can see but I am not sure how many illustrations the books have. Some are much more illustrated than others. Overall an amazing price for such precious, precious knowledge.
