I was especially pleased that he seems to be a genuinely kind person. No ego, no hype, just very real and very nice. He never says a bad word about anyone, yet is quite honest about being inside the world of XXX films. And he answers every question you've always had and more you never dreamed of. One of the male mega-stars of the Adult Film Industry has provided us with a no-holds-barred insider's glimpse into the billion dollar industry that everyone watches but rarely discusses. The book is quite a fast read, to the point, and covers so much information as well as lets us in on who Mr. St. Croix really is -- down to earth and quite real. The book is written in an interview-like style. His longevity in the industry (some twenty years) is also a plus when it comes to getting to know all of the insides of the business (remember, this is primary source material): he discusses his initial contract with Vivid pictures through what it's like to actually work on the set of one of his films and what goes on before and after the scenes. We don't get to see this part of the business and it's eye-opening. Get hold of it -- you won't regret it! He's a smart guy and he enjoys his work and it has paid off for him because, well, how many other men in the industry have lasted as long as he has??? I add also that the book is not seedy in any way but very positive and paints quite a different picture from what you would think working in adult films would be like. A++ all the way. Kudos, Mr. St. Croix and let's hope that you can provide us with something even more generous in future to enjoy!

Steven St. Croix's take on the life as a male adult actor is an interesting, yet informative, view of those in the Adult film industry. This is a very smart man who loves sex on a molecular level and adores most of the women he works with a similar intensity while having sex with them. Yet, without any hint of self aggrandizement, his unflinching look at an industry he loves makes it clear that he is among a vanished and vanishing generation of adult performers. If you love adult films you will likely come away with some despair for the future of this genre as well. No, this is not a work of literature. It's filled with typos and occasional errors in syntax. Fewer books have editors nowadays. But it rated 5 stars in my view because it is intelligent, well written, keenly insightful, and greatly exceeded my expectations.

Whatever Steven does, either acting or having sex on screen, he puts effort into it and he is always great at whatever he does.. So I read this book with the anticipation that it would be a well written, interesting book, since Steve is the author. And it is! Steve really delves into all aspects of porn including subjects I wouldn't even think of, eg , What education level do most porn stars have. I liked the book from the first line and was never bored, the only thing is I wanted more! When the book was over, I was clicking my mouse hoping it wasn't over. This is an excellent first time effort by Steven, I really look forward to his upcoming works.
