

Reading this book was like a whistle stop tour of every UFO sighting in Russia and beyond, an

exhausting experience as it seems that Russia is swarming with unidentified objects of every shape, size and disposition. I was fascinated and amazed at the sheer volume of reports and the refreshingly matter of fact attitude of Russian authorities. It wasn't at all what I expected. On the downside, the book contains so many reports that by the halfway mark I had reached saturation point and found myself flicking pages. I felt that instead of addressing hundreds of sightings at a superficial level ie just a couple of paragraphs for each, there was plenty of scope for examining different categories or geographic areas in more depth. This would provide a better paced, less intense reading experience. For example, in one area UFOs were said to only visit in the spring and in another area the UFOs were reportedly aggressive towards people. I wanted to know more but frustratingly there was no further expansion of the subject. In summary: this is is a fascinating read but I feel the author has an opportunity to do more with this astonishing collection of material.
