

after it plunged into a icy cold river in Spanish Fork, Utah. First responders, including police officer & Co-author Tyler Beddoes, were taped saying afterwards that a woman's voice was calling "Help me!" from inside the car. In the police video of the rescue, an officer can be heard calling back, "We're helping, we're coming!"With the car partially submerged in the icy waters,18 month old Lily Groesbeck was found alive, but her mother had died instantly in the wreck, thus the cries for help were never explained. Beddoes said the voice did not sound like it was from a living person,"It was an adult woman's voice. A calming voice," he said, adding that several other officers heard the same thing.Best selling author Ptolemy Tompkins weaves in much interesting angel lore and other similar stories.The base story is true and fascinating and the added info about angels is well written.
