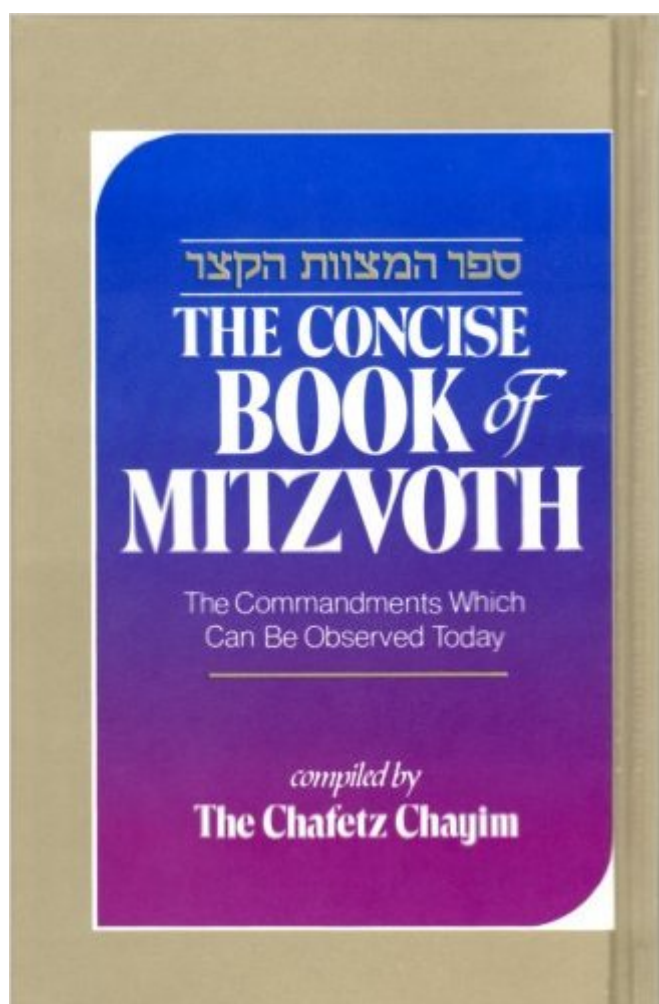

The Concise Book of Mitzvoth was written to group together the Biblical commandments that are applicable today. The book includes discussion about belief in God, shabbos, and kashrus. Sections about kindness are favorites of the author, as are the themes of self improvement. The Chofetz Chaim is beloved in the Jewish world as a phenomenal personality who personified Jewish unity and kindness.

Very valuable reference tool where all the Mitzvoth can be quickly found. This sefer should be in every English speaking Jew's, and/or Noahide's library, and I would recommend it's addition to the bookshelf of anyone, of any faith, who wants to have a very concise list of all 613 Commandments that are contained within the first five books of the Tanakh (Hebrew scriptures).
