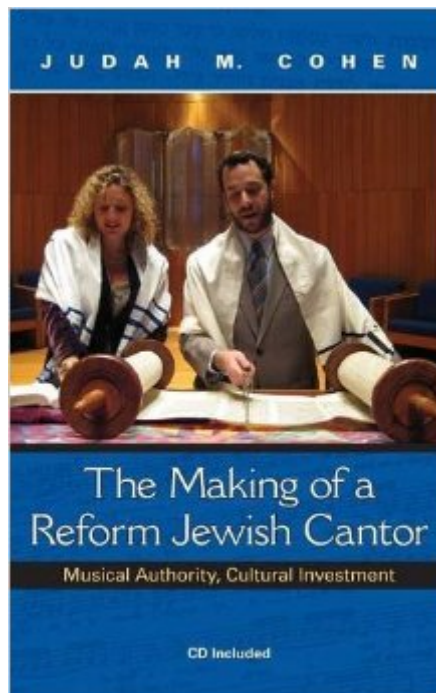

I am an oral historian preparing to interview a Reform cantor about her life, training, and experience, and her vision of the future of Reform Judaism. I was just starting my research when I came upon this book. Was it a huge help to me? Yes, it was. First, for an academic-quality work in nonfiction, *The Making of a Reform Cantor* was extremely readable, which I appreciated, since so many academic books are a collection of potentially brilliant thoughts lost forever in the convolutions of language. Next, the book lives up to its title--the reader really does learn in considerable, but not too great, detail how a Reform cantor is fashioned. Dr. Cohen's account of the school's curricula and

practice was so thorough that I can probably cancel my trip to visit the School of Sacred Music to see for myself. I also appreciated Dr. Cohen's approaching the highly charged arena where cantorial art versus congregational singing is debated. It's a hot topic these days and he handled it nimbly.
